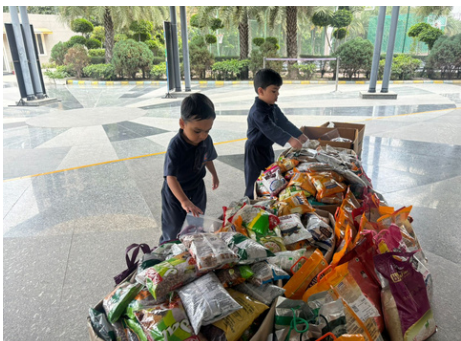
SPORTS

Our state-of-the-art Sports Arena offers a world-class athletic experience with facilities built to international standards. Here, students train under expert coaches in a broad spectrum of disciplines—from athletics (sprints, relays, shot put, discus, long jump) and gymnastics (floor exercises, vault, parallel bars, pommel horse) to synthetic basketball, 8 air-conditioned badminton courts, and Olympic-standard table tennis with 15 tables. The campus also supports cricket, horse riding, competitive shooting in a 10-meter range (with electronic and manual targets), swimming in a 50 m Olympic-sized pool, squash, tennis, and golf. At Prometheus, sportsmanship, teamwork, and holistic well-being are integral to every student's development.



School Extra Curricular

We are committed to developing students into caring global citizens who prioritize the well-being of their communities and the world at large. Our students actively engage in projects with NGOs like Sai Kripa. We introduced 'Project Kripa' in 2024, a student-led initiative focused on six social drives. We offer tutoring & mentoring, tree planting, toy drives, community wedding support, health check-ups, and a "No one should starve" drive. Students can also join clubs for sports, creativity, and leadership like Entrepreneurship, Robotics, and Debate. We also have an Interact Club in school.



Prometheus High School Diploma (PHSD)

The Prometheus High School Diploma (PHSD) presents a well-defined path for students to steadily progress towards a promising future. Earning the PHSD entails fulfilling the IB/Cambridge curriculum requirements. The diploma's prerequisites are credit-based and span from grades 9 to 12, categorized into Enrichment and Academic credits.

Recognition Levels: Students receive the PHSD at the end of grade 12 in one of the categories of GOLD, SILVER, or BRONZE, according to the credit system requirements for the specific year.

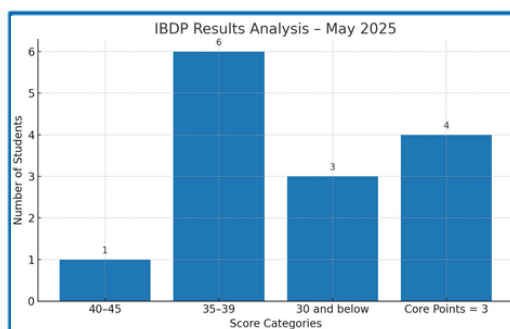
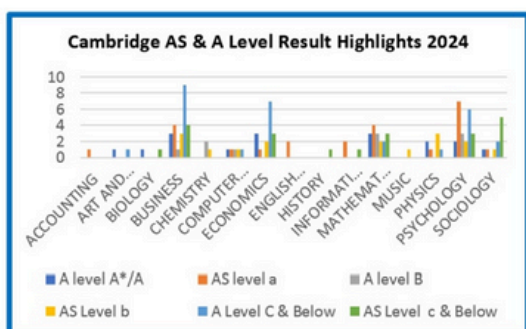

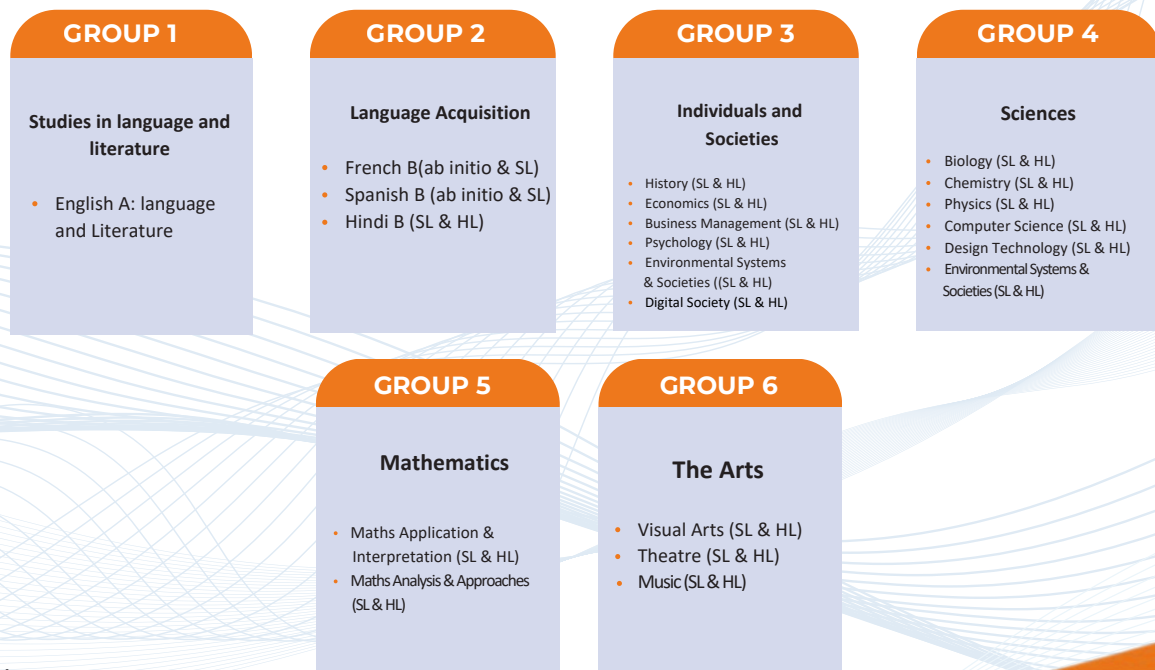
