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1. School Vision

2. School Mission

3. Core Beliefs

Prometheus School is dedicated to supporting excellence across academics, sports, arts, and other talent domains. Our aim is to spark curiosity, foster innovation, and develop globally minded learners with strong entrepreneurial and leadership abilities.

4. Definitions

A scholarship is a merit-based financial award that offers a partial or full waiver of tuition fees. All additional fees listed in the school's fee schedule remain applicable unless explicitly stated otherwise.

5. Scholarships Offered

a) Academic Scholarships

Awarded to students who consistently demonstrate outstanding academic performance over the last two academic years.

Curriculum Minimum Eligibility

CBSE	95% and above
ICSE	95% and above
MYP	Minimum 54 out of 56 points
IGCSE	Minimum 5 A* grades
Other Boards	Equivalent performance matrix determined by the school

b) Arts Scholarships

Awarded to students with exceptional artistic accomplishments at the national or international level.

- Students winning top-tier national or international awards may receive a one-time 20% tuition fee waiver.

c) Sports Scholarships (Revised Structure - 2025)

Applicable for Grades 6, 7, 8, 9, and 11.

Eligible Sports:

Swimming, Table Tennis, Shooting, Football, Basketball, Gymnastics, Badminton, Cricket, Squash, Tennis, Chess

Sports Scholarship Categories

Category	Criteria / Level of Achievement	Scholarship Award
International Athlete	Federation-affiliated competitions	100% waiver on tuition fees and all one-time fees (admission, registration, security)
National Medalist	Junior/Senior National Championships (Federation Affiliated) – Rank 1, 2, or 3	100% waiver on tuition fees and all one-time fees
Khelo India Youth Games Medalist	Federation Affiliated – Rank 1, 2, or 3	100% waiver on tuition fees and all one-time fees
SGFI / CBSE National Medalist	Rank 1, 2, or 3	75% tuition fee waiver
ISSO Medalist	National-level ISSO competition – Gold Medal	50% tuition fee waiver

All applicants must undergo mandatory trials and documentation verification as outlined in Section 12.

d) Other Areas of Excellence

Scholarships may be awarded for exceptional achievement in:

- Leadership
 - Technology
 - Design
 - Service
 - Other meritorious fields at the discretion of school leadership
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6. Scholarship Budget (2026-27)

- Grades 6-8: ₹80 lakhs (15 students)
 - Grades 9-10: ₹80 lakhs (10 students)
 - Grades 11-12: ₹40 lakhs (5 students)
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7. Policy for Existing and New Prometheus Students

- Scholarships are awarded at the sole discretion of the school management.
- Scholarships for new admissions are strictly merit-based.
- Scholarships granted in Grade 9 or Grade 11 continue for two academic years, subject to annual review.
- Scholarship recipients must maintain strong academic performance, discipline, and a positive contribution to school life.

Scholarships may be withdrawn with one term's notice if:

- o The student does not maintain the required ranking for the specific criterion.
 - o The annual review outcome is unsatisfactory.
 - o The student is removed on disciplinary grounds (withdrawal will be immediate).
- Scholarships may be awarded at **20%, 25%, 50%, 75%, or 100%** of tuition fees.
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8. Annual Review Process

- Mid-year performance targets may be assigned if concerns arise.
 - Parents will receive written communication outlining expectations.
 - Decisions made after the annual review are final.
 - The school reserves the right to modify the scholarship policy annually.
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9. Scholarship Committee

Responsible for evaluating applications, conducting interviews, verifying documentation, and approving awards.

Core Committee Members:

- Chairman & Head of School
- Head of Admissions
- School Principals / School Heads

Additional Members (Sports Scholarships):

- Mr. Karamvir Dagar – Chief Swimming Coach

- Committee decisions are final and binding.
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10. Grade Applicability

Scholarships are available for:

- Grade 6
 - Grade 7
 - Grade 8
 - Grade 9
 - Grade 11
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11. Duration of Scholarships for Grade 9 and Grade 11

To support students during key academic transitions:

- Academic Scholarships awarded in Grade 9 continue through Grade 10.
- Academic Scholarships awarded in Grade 11 continue through Grade 12.

Sports scholarship continuation is subject to satisfactory annual review and maintenance of ranking criteria.

12. Sports Scholarship Trials & Verification Requirements

1. Sports Trials

- Mandatory participation in structured trials led by designated coaches.
- Assessments include:
 - o Technical skill
 - o Physical fitness
 - o Tactical understanding
 - o Discipline, commitment, and training readiness
- Coaches will submit a formal evaluation to the Scholarship Committee.

2. Verification of Achievements

- All medals, certificates, rankings, and participation records must be authenticated by the Sports Department.
- Verification includes:
 - o Authenticity of documents
 - o Validity of issuing association/federation
 - o Accuracy of rank and competition level
- Only verified achievements will be considered.

3. Final Recommendation

- The Sports Department will submit a consolidated report (trial results + document verification).
- Scholarships may be withheld if:
 - o Trial performance does not align with claimed achievements
 - o Documents cannot be authenticated
 - o The student displays insufficient potential or commitment
